## ELIGIBILITY FOR APAC SERVICES

- The term “waiting families” signifies those families approved to adopt through DHR who await placement.
- All foster parents with a child in the home whose ISP includes adoption by that family are counted as adoptive parents. That child is counted as an adopted child.
